## Ownership Analysis Report: Edge Growth Business Development (Pty) Ltd

The ownership analysis below is based on the Codes of Good Practice on Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment published by the Department of Trade and Industry on 11 October 2013, in terms of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act 53 of 2003.

This report is aimed at providing a black ownership status of Edge Growth Business Development by applying the Modified Flow-Through Principle method from African Rainbow Capital (Pty) Ltd, Edge Growth ESOP Trust and Jayesh Nair.

The ownership analysis is based on the principles contained in Statement 100, Code 100 of the Codes of Good Practice covering the recognition and measurement of black ownership. Relevant documented substantive evidence was used to make these findings.
